Dear Virtual Museum of Canada Editorial Board:

The Textile Museum of Canada (TMC) is the only museum in Canada solely dedicated to the collection, exhibition and documentation of textiles from around the world. The TMC has gained international recognition for the quality and importance of its collection, and the excellence of its exhibitions and programming. The collection of more than 11,000 pieces represents over 200 countries and regions, several thousand of these textiles are now available for on-line viewing at www.canadiantapestry.ca.

We have identified eight pieces in the TMC collection of particular relevance to the project "A Woman's Place" Virtual Exhibition Project Maltwood Art Museum and Gallery, Victoria BC, and we would be pleased to contribute the use of digital images of these pieces to the proposed virtual exhibition. The pieces are of special note because of their connection to the early Chinese community in Victoria, an area which I understand has been underrepresented in the project to date. In addition to furthering the AWP project research, this collaboration will also benefit the TMC by promoting and disseminating its holdings to a potentially new audience.
